The Hawke's Bay Helicopter Rescue Trust is a charitable trust established to provide a dedicated rescue helicopter service to the Hawke's Bay region. Each year the rescue helicopter service assists in over 360 missions within the region. The rescue helicopter is also utilised for Police and National Search and Rescue operations, fire, education, training and demonstrations.

The Hawke's Bay Helicopter Rescue Service operates 24 hours, 7 days a week and is FREE of charge to anyone who may require urgent transportation following a serious accident or illness, when it is considered to be the appropriate means of transport, by the Ambulance Control Centre.

65% of funding to operate the service comes from individuals, families, businesses and sponsors. Your support really will make a difference - the rewards will be lifesaving.

## What is Payroll Giving?

Payroll Giving is an easy way to support the Lowe Corporation Rescue Helicopter Service. It is a voluntary scheme, which is administered through the Inland Revenue Department. As an employee, you can make donations directly from your pay for as little or as much as you like and for every dollar you donate you'll receive a third back as a tax credit in the same pay period.

## Employee Benefits

Supporting your local Rescue Helicopter through the Payroll Giving scheme provides you with the following benefits;

- All donations through the Payroll Giving scheme are tax deductible
- It is easy to setup, you only need to take a few moments and complete one form for your regular donation to begin
