

This lottery is being run by the Hawke's Bay Rescue Helicopter Trust ("HBRHT"). By purchasing a ticket, you agree to be bound by the terms and conditions below which apply to this lottery.

Tickets

1. There are 11,800 tickets offered for purchase in this lottery, which are numbered from H00001 to H11,800 inclusive.
2. Tickets are NZ \$45 per ticket (inclusive of GST).
3. There is no limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased by any one person.
4. Tickets will be available for purchase from 12.01am Monday 1 July 2024 until 11.59pm Monday 30 September 2024 (unless sold out prior).
5. Tickets will be issued by email. If no email address is provided, a printed ticket will be posted to the address specified at the time of purchase.

Eligibility

6. To be eligible to purchase a ticket in this lottery you must be 18 years or over and you must be in New Zealand at the time of the purchase of the ticket.
7. HBRHT Contractors/Staff, HBRHT Board Trustees and immediate crew working in association with the Lowe Corporate Rescue Helicopter Service and their immediate families, are ineligible to participate in the lottery.
8. Evidence of the winner's identity and eligibility must be provided to the HBRHT, or its legal advisors, within 14 days of the date of the prize draw so that transfer of ownership can be completed. If not provided, the prize will be forfeited, and HBRHT will refund the ticket purchase price to all ticket purchasers.

Prize

9. By purchasing a ticket you enter into the draw to win one (1) of three (3) prizes
 1. Ford Ranger Wildtrak 3.0I V6 4WD valued at \$86,500 (inc GST).
 2. 1 x Scott Strike Eride 940 mountain bike – Large frame (Blue), 1 x Scott Strike Eride Contessa 930 mountain bike – Medium frame (Bronze) and 2 x HBMTBC Adult Membership (2024 / 2025) valued at \$15,150 (inc GST).
 3. Apple Technology package including; Mac book air 13", iPhone 15 128gb, iPad 10.2 wifi, Apple watch 45mm and Apple tv 64gb valued at \$5,175 (inc GST).

As at the date of these terms and conditions the total value of the prizes are NZ\$106,218.00 (inc GST) but this value may differ at the time of the prize draw.

The prizes are the confirmed prizes and are non-transferable for cash and are not exchangeable.

Prize Draw

13. The prize draw will be by blind selection of the numbers associated with the tickets sold, under supervision of an independent witness in accordance with Rule 6 (14) of the Gambling Act (Lottery) Game Rules 2004.
14. The results of the prize draw will be published in the Hawke's Bay Today on Thursday 3rd October 2024, on the HBRHT website and the HBRHT social media platforms.
15. The prize winners will be contacted by telephone and notified in writing.
16. An email will be sent to all ticket holders notifying them of the winners of the prizes.
17. As a condition of entry, the winners agree that their details, photographs, and video footage may be used for publicity and/or promotional purposes.

Collection of Prize

18. The winners must collect their prize from the Graeme Lowe Rescue Helicopter Centre, Gate 6, Orchard Road, Hastings within 3 months of the prize draw. If the prize is not collected in this timeframe the prize will be forfeited and the HBRHT will refund the ticket purchase price to all ticket purchasers.
19. All costs associated with collection of the prize are the responsibility of the winners.

Insurance

20. It is the winners responsibility to arrange their own insurances and they acknowledge that the HBRHT has no responsibility for providing insurance after the handover of the prizes.

Use of funds raised

21. Funds raised from this lottery will be used towards the provision of an emergency, air search & rescue and air ambulance service in Hawke's Bay.

Ticket Holder Authorisations

22. You authorise the HBRHT to retain your name and contact details in their database and to use them to keep you informed of future offers, promotional events and/or fundraising activities that the HBRHT believes may be of interest to you (Promotional Materials).

23. If you do not wish to receive Promotional Materials you will be entitled to opt out of them using the unsubscribe feature.

Cancellation of Lottery

24. HBRHT reserves the right to cancel the lottery at any time prior to the prize draw.

25. In the event of a cancellation of this lottery, the cancellation will be published on the HBRHT website, social media, and in the Hawke's Bay Today newspaper. In the event of a cancellation HBRHT will refund the ticket purchase price to all ticket purchasers.

Gambling Act

26. The Lottery is conducted by license issued by the Department of Internal affairs under the Gambling Act 2003. License Number LT090000569.
