Rescue Helicopter Celebrates 25 Years with Unison

Two of Hawke's Bay's vital essential services are marking a 'powerful' partnership milestone this month. Local power lines company, Unison Networks (Unison) has been backing the Lowe Corporation Rescue Helicopter as an Associate Sponsor for 25 years, helping save thousands of Kiwi lives in that time.

A special presentation at the hangar last night officially acknowledged Unison as a core pillar of support for the region's medical air rescue service.

Hawke's Bay Rescue Helicopter Trust CEO, Andy Quayle says the partnership has stood the test of time.
